PARENT GUIDELINES

To enroll your child in a class:

- ◆ Make checks payable to the instructor listed on the flyer.

Please complete the registration form for each class in which you would like to enroll your child/ren. **Send, along with payment, DIRECTLY to the provider. Only scholarship applicants should direct registration forms & any payment to PTA Box in the main office.** See Scholarship Info. page for details on eligibility and application process.

To ensure the success and continuation of this program, we ask our Glenview community the following:

- ◆ Please make sure your child knows the time and place of his/her enrichment class. It is important that students be on their best behavior and instructed to go directly to the class after school. Children with behavior problems to, from and during class may not be allowed to continue attending these programs.
- ◆ It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to ensure that the student is either enrolled in Adventure Time or supervised by an adult while on school premises. There is **no supervision provided after class dismissal.** **Please be on time to pick up your child!**
- ◆ Please note that if your child is enrolled in a class that does not start within 10 minutes of school dismissal, unless your child will be attending Adventure Time (AT) or Learning Spot (LS), it is **your responsibility** to arrange for adult supervision for your child while he/she is waiting for his/her class to begin. Please do not sign your child up for such after-school programs unless you can arrange for **regular** and **consistent** adult supervision for your child while on campus. Neither the school nor the PTA is responsible for your children's whereabouts during these times.
- ◆ Students enrolled in Adventure Time: AT will receive a roster of students enrolled in the enrichment programs and escort children to and from these classes. Students enrolled in Learning Spot: Parents/Guardians should inform LS of any after-school enrichment classes their children are enrolled in.
- ◆ Please take note of dates when class is canceled. Classes do not meet on school holidays. There may be other times when a class does not meet for some other reason. Please read flyers carefully for information on specific classes, and check the PTA bulletin board for updates and changes.
- ◆ If there are insufficient sign-ups for a class, the class will be cancelled and payment returned by the instructor.
- ◆ Please note: Due to an increasing number of scholarship requests and limited budgets, this year Glenview PTA offers **partial (75%) scholarships** for all classes to qualified applicants on a **first come first serve basis.** **Please read the PTA Scholarship Application & Donation Form carefully.** To qualify and register for a class, return completed scholarship request form with partial payment indicated (25% tuition, checks payable to Glenview PTA) to PTA Box in main office. Be sure to indicate on the form which **class, time, and day** you are interested in. You will be contacted with the status of your scholarship request before the first day of the class in which you want to enroll.
- ◆ Please note: Many providers have generously offered **1-2 full Scholarships/class** to early applicants, **first come first serve.** Qualifications still apply. You must submit the **completed** PTA Scholarship Application Form **along with the indicated partial payment** (checks payable to Glenview PTA) to be considered. Qualified applicants will be notified and their partial payment returned.

PTA Scholarship Application opens on Tuesday, Jan 12th and ends on Tuesday, Feb 2nd. Send your completed Application form along with payment ASAP! (please note, **request forms received without payment will not be considered complete** and completed application received before 1/12 will be considered received on 1/12)
